## Charity

Heroes in Transition (HIT) is a not-for-profit organization that was founded in memory of Captain Eric A. Jones, USMC, in August of 2010. Heroes in Transition recognizes the bravery and service of our men and women in uniform, especially those who have served in the Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom conflicts, by providing assistance that is not readily available from other organizations, including local, state and federal agencies. It is their mission to seek out unique opportunities to aid US veterans and their families directly. Heroes in Transition provides appropriate assistance to those with special needs in four primary areas: home modifications for disabled veterans, transitional support group therapy, financial support for service families, and assistance dogs for veterans.

In the past year alone, HIT has funded a home renovation for a disabled Army Captain, doubled the state budget for The Montrose VA Food Pantry in NY, funded the training of multiple service dogs for disabled veterans, and created and funded an equine therapy program to help returning veterans and their families re-acclimate to civilian life.
